Courses run by Dashmesh Educational Charitable Trust

The Dashmesh Educational Charitable Trust developed the required infrastructure at Budhera, Gurgaon and received permission from the concerned departments and authorities to commence the following medical courses:

(1) Bachelor of Dental Surgery (BDS)

The BDS course has been recognized w.e.f. 25.10.2006 by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India which has been published in Part II Section 3 of sub section (II) of the Gazette of India vide notification dated the 17th July, 2007.

(2) Master of Dental Surgery (MDS)

Govt. of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare granted permission vide letter F.No. V.12017/20/2007-DE dated the 19th May, 2008 for starting of MDS course with intake of 18 seats in seven specialities from the academic session 2008-09.

(3) Bachelor of Physiotherapy (BPT)

M.D. University, Rohtak gave provisional affiliation to Dashmesh College of Physiotherapy for starting BPT course with an intake of 60 seats from the session 2008-09 vide letter no. CB-VI/Dashmesh-Phy.08/12876 dated 24.07.2008.

(4) Dental Mechanics Course (DMC)

The Dental Council of India accorded permission to start Dental Mechanics Course vide letter no. DE-6(66)-2008/A4734 dated the 16th September, 2008 with intake of 15 seats from the session 2008-09.

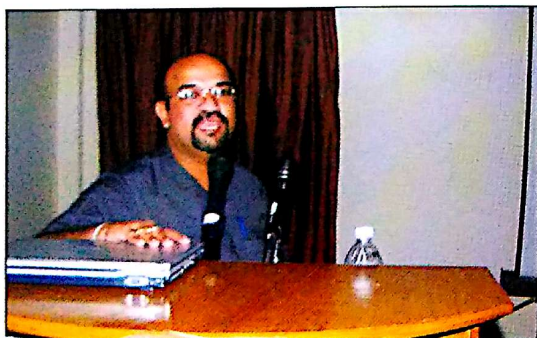

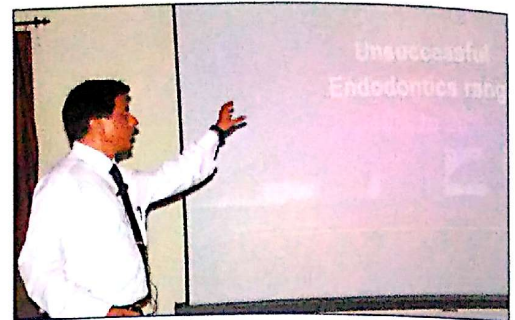

संचालित गुरु गोविन्द सिंह अस्पताल एवं डेन्टल कॉलेज द्वारा नियमित तौर पर स्वास्थ्य कैम्प आयोजित किये जाते हैं। विगत जनवरी 2008 से अब तक करीब 123 कैम्प लगाये गये जिनमें डेन्टल एवं मेडिकल के 15456 मरीजों का स्वास्थ्य परीक्षण किया गया। 3 मार्च 2008 को मौजाबाद के सामाजिक कार्यकर्ता श्री किशन एवं साथियों के सौजन्य से एक बड़ा कैम्प भी किया गया, इसमें आस-पास के 10 गाँवों के मरीज आये। इस कैम्प का उद्घाटन जिला पंचायत, गुडगाँव, के अध्यक्ष श्री अभय राव ने किया।

Oral Health Survey

SGT Dental College has undertaken an Oral Health Survey in September, 2008 in village Budhera, Gurgaon in which the Department of Oral Medicine & Radiology and the Department of Preventive and Community Dentistry are participating. Dr. Vishal Dang is coordinating the survey. The main motive of the survey is to make the patients aware of present status of their health, education and motivation and identify the individuals who need help. The PCD staff, OMR, post-graduate students, interns and students of BDS Third year are involved in the survey who visit the village every Saturday.

During the survey, information is collected on the 1997 W.H.O. Oral Health Assessment Form. In the course of the survey many hidden cases with oral lesions and other dental problems come to the notice of the survey team. These cases are motivated and then referred to the Institute for further investigation and treatment.

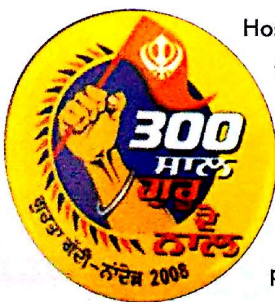
