

The wellbeing Association under community Health Nursing Department, Faculty of Nursing, SGT University, Gurugram has organized a health awareness camp for 'AneamiaMukt Bharat (AMB)' with focus on its 6×6×6 STRATEGY, at Mubarakpur Village –Gurugram (HR) on 09th February 2023 at 10:30am.

The main objective of the event was to connect and expand awareness among patients about Aneamia conditions, its symptoms; and to encourage individuals to take preventive steps to avoid Aneamia. The main focus remains on women of reproductive age as they are more prone to Anaemia in Indian villages. Total 74 patientvisited camp.

The 6x6x6 strategy under AMB implies six age groups, six interventions and six institutional mechanisms. The strategy focuses on ensuring supply chain, demand generation and strong monitoring using the dashboard for addressing anaemia, both due to nutritional and non-nutritional causes.

The activities in AMB camp included Aneamia assessment for patients, Hemoglobin (Hb) estimation and their counselling.

The program was organized by B.Sc. Nursing 4th year and M.Sc. Nursing 2nd Year students under the supervision of faculty members of the community Health Nursing Department and under guidance of Prof. (Dr.) Sunil K.
