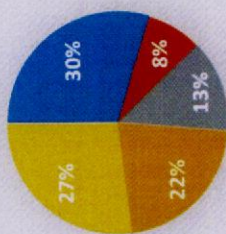

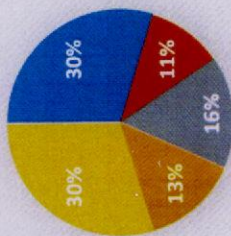

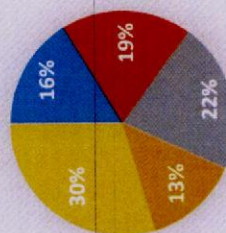

**Q2: The practicals/lab experiments enhanced understanding of concepts of theory**



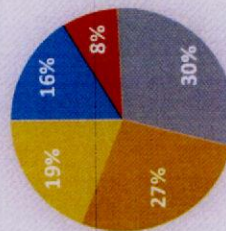

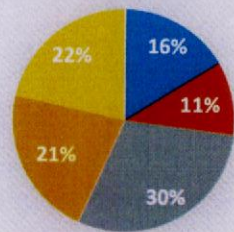

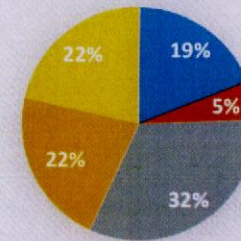

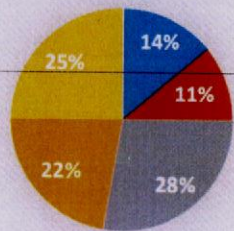

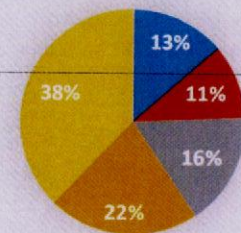

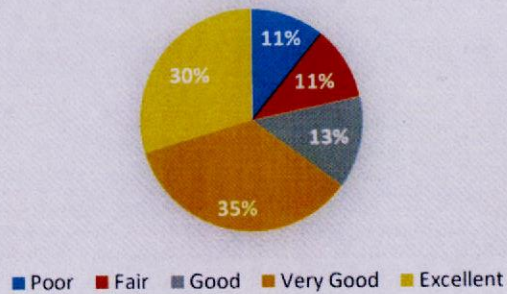

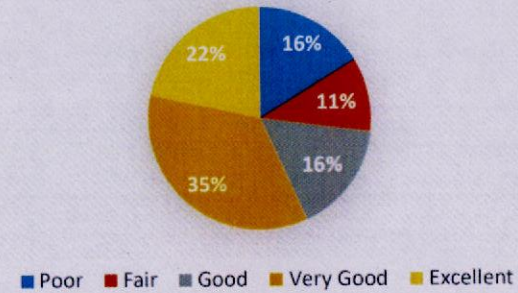
  
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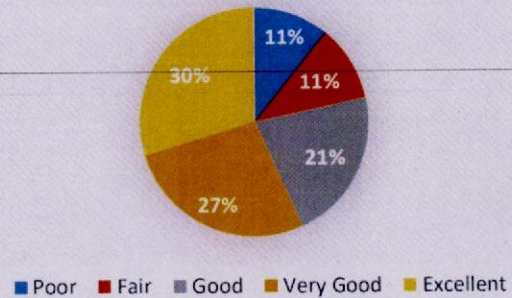
Q9: The teacher's ability in explaining areas of confusion



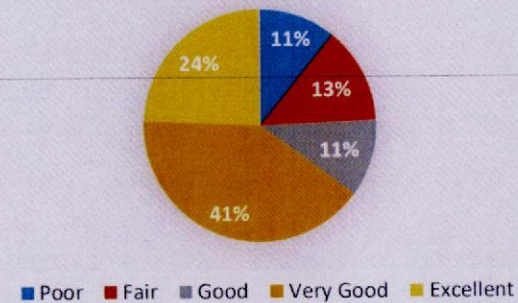
Q10: Overall environment in the class is conducive to learning



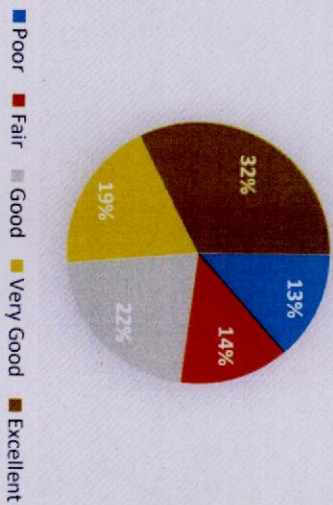
Q11: The contents of syllabus were appropriately sequenced



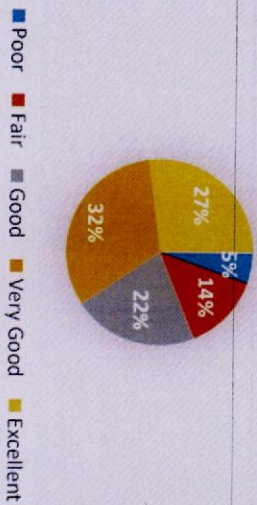
Q12: The course content stimulated your interest in the subject area



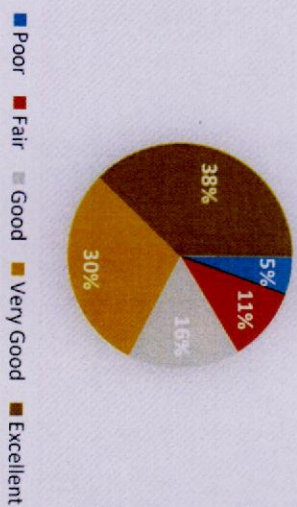
**Q13: Syllabus was covered well within time**



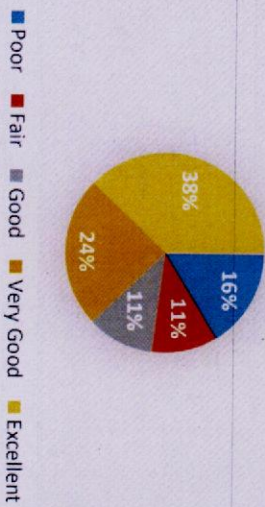
**Q15: The sequence of internal/ sessional examinations is helpful in covering the whole course content**




**Q14: Tests and examinations are conducted well within time**

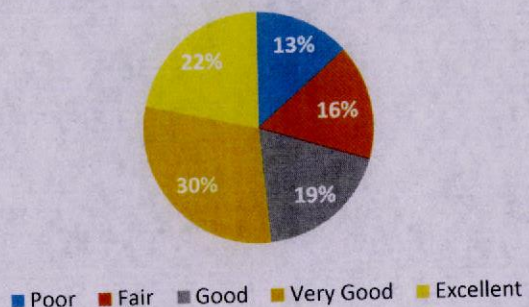


**Q16: Rate your experience with the inclusion of Objective type Questions in the Exam paper**
