Endoscopic control revealed no perforation and total time taken during procedure was using around half the time taken during direct sinus lift. With the ECOSFE, perforations of the sinus membrane can be visualized. Although this technique is less invasive than the lateral window technique, it cannot be recommended as a standard procedure in the posterior maxilla because of the large amount of additional equipment needed and the technically demanding procedure.</p>
